

PRESBYTERIAN MANSE, 1974 MAIN STREET, FORESTER'S FALLS

Originally this was the manse for the Methodist Church next door, but in 1925, the Methodists joined with other denominations to become the United Church. The local United pastor was designated to serve two churches, here and in Beachburg, 20 kilometres northwest. Beachburg had a larger congregation, so the pastor lived there, leaving this manse vacant. But not for long! The local Presbyterians who had a beautiful big church about six kilometres east of the village, and who voted in 1925, not to join the Methodists in Union, decided they preferred



this manse to their own, and moved in, next door to the congregation they'd rejected!
