

## WAITE HOUSE, 101 WAITE STREET, FORESTER'S FALLS

The street is named for John Ellard Waite, one of the village's prime entrepreneurs, who operated a brick yard in this area for more than 60 years. His family lived along this street, and most of their elegant homes, like this one, are made from bricks manufactured only a few steps away; in fact, if you took a close look at most of the older brick homes in this part of the Ottawa Valley, you'll find the "JEW" stamp. You'll see some of those bricks in the Ross Museum.
